The recorder pointed out the date was incorrect on the agenda.

Motion to accept the agenda as corrected was made by council member Graham, seconded by council Member Hescock. Ayes: Hescock, Graham, Kirk and Blackmon.

Motion Passed.

Public Input: Steven Caldwell, Valley Street. His concern is the concern of the condition of Valley St. It has pot holes and feels that the dirt condition of part of the road encourages people to come up there and park at night. (attached)

Discussion.

Richard Twamley: asking when the fire hydrant will be placed on Baker Av.

Public works intends to place that this fall; we are short handed right now.

Eileen Weeks: Eileen had made an agreement with the council that allowed her to put off paying on her water/sewer bill for a few months. This agreement was to allow her to get another bill paid off and then use that same amount of money, monthly, to get her City bill paid off.

The agreement was that she would be able to start making payments to the City this month (July).

Eileen is here tonight to explain that she is unable to start making payments to the City because her living room floor fell in. She is strapped financially and is looking for help. She has no intentions of disregarding the agreement but she is really struggling right now. She also was unable to pay off the other bill.

Public works report: The treatment plant upgrade construction will be starting around August 15th. It needs to be done by sometime in October.

Tree removal. The original party never came back to the City after looking at the trees. Bob Wampler is going to look at the areas but he stated it is going to be expensive.

Discussion.

The Mayor knows the other gentleman and he will give him a call and request a bid, again.

Fire hydrant on Baker Av.: Hescock said he would get to that as soon as the new man came and they got lined out.

Culverts: discussion about the drain ditches. This is going to be expensive to put in culverts under the road. This project is still under discussion and planning. Adkins is going to bring to council some different options and some aprox. costs.

Discussion about getting Valley street graded.

Motion to accept the public works report was made by council member Blackmon, seconded by council member Graham. Ayes: Graham, Hescoock, Kirk and Blackmon.

Motion passed.

Mayor's report: Nothing to report tonight.

Police Committee report: Council member Erion is out of town.

Recorders report: There is a request to have a donation for school supplies again.

Motion to donate #100.00 for school supplies was made by council member Hescoock, seconded by council member Graham. Ayes: Hescoock, Graham, Kirk and Blackmon.

The recorder went to Burns and met with the Auditors about the 2008 IRS discrepancies. The audits feel the IRS has just not got everything in their computer. All the reports filed are copied and everything they are concerned about has been sent to them. We wrote a letter, sent copies of everything they have received prior and got that sent off.

August 19th the recorder will be in Salem at training.

New business: The mayor asked the council to grant Eileen Weeks an extension for 30 days on her payment agreement.

Motion to appoint Carolyn Blackmon the liaison to the clerk and to return Floyd Hescoock to the Mayor ProTem position was made by council member Graham, seconded by council member Kirk. Ayes: Hescoock, Graham, Blackmon and Kirk.

The recorder told council there is going to be a farewell barbeque for Kay, Mike and Allen.

Motion to declare Council member Prewitt and Council member Graham council positions open was made by council member Blackmon, seconded by council member Hescoock. Ayes: Hescoock, Graham, Blackmon and Kirk.

Motion passed.
